There has been Bermuda sod placed on the first and eighth Ladies tees and will not be available for use for several weeks, Temporary ladies tees have been added to the side of these tees where the red and white markers are located. The golf course will be closed to golfers for a week, from Monday (10/13)through Friday (10/17) for golf course over seeding and other golf course projects prior to the league starting on Monday (10/20).

POOL INFO



This new enclosed fence attached to the pool building will contain our large chlorine tank and smaller acid tanks that are currently inside the pool building. We've tried a variety of different things over the past 2 years to lower the negative results of the chemical fumes inside the pool building that have been corroding our motors, pumps and other parts inside the building. With the chemicals being outside the building in a locked contained area, this should eliminate the problem and ultimately save money and pool closure time. We have to do a few more things before the transfer happens, but we're well on our way!



Our Florida Department of Health License for pool and hot tub license states that the hours the pool is licensed to be used is from sunrise to sunset. Any hours before and after are in violation of our Florida State license and can result in the closing of our pool. Unfortunately, we have residents and/or their guests using the hot tub and pool after hours and often during severe thunder and lightning storms along with heavy rains. A person can be killed during these conditions. We have videos of these actions. Again, please abide by our Department of Health License and make sure that your family and other guests abide by these pool and hot tub hours as well. Thanks for your cooperation and compliance, LHE Board of Directors
