


ARTS & CRAFTS SESSIONS

DIY NATURAL WEED KILLER

You asked for this less toxic weed killer that actually works. (Pet safe)

- 1 gallon white vinegar
- 2 cups Epsom salt
- 1/4 cup Dawn dish liquid (blue original)

Mix together in a watering can or sprayer and spray directly onto weeds. Use care around plants you wish to keep. If you use commercial 30% vinegar, use 1/2 gallon vinegar and 1/2 gallon water.
